Anchor System Instructions

How to Get Your Anchor Equipment

- Anchor points are installed at each stall site on the footpath along The Esplanade.
- Pick up your anchor equipment from market staff as soon as you arrive on Sunday morning.
- Contact Sunday Market Staff: \ 0403 604 119

Permanent vs Casual Traders

- Permanent Traders: Keep your anchor set for ongoing use.
- Casual Traders: Return your anchor set to Stall 001 at the end of the day.

How to Use the Anchor System

You can secure your marquee or umbrella in two ways:

Option 1: Direct Bolt-In Method

- Remove the grub screw protecting the anchor point from dirt. Place them somewhere safe.
- Open vour marquee
- Insert the eye bolt through the foot of your marquee into each of the four anchor points.

Option 2: Cam Buckle Tie Method

- Remove the grub screw protecting the anchor point from dirt. Place them somewhere safe.
- Insert the eye bolt into the anchor point.
- Open your marquee
- Use cam buckle ties to secure your marquee or umbrella from the inside of the frame to the eye bolt.

What You Need

- Provided by Market (on your first trade day):
 - 4 x M10-SS Eye Bolts with Collar
 - 1 x Allen Key



You Must Purchase: 4 x Cam Buckle Ties (rated to hold 180kg – approx)

Using the System Safely and Effectively

General Guidelines

- Only use cam buckle ties rated for 180kg.
- If using your own straps, you must provide **engineering documentation** for approval.
- You may stabilise using your back wall only on high wind days, but back anchors must still be used.

Extra Stability Tip

- For a stronger hold, connect two cam buckle ties diagonally:
 - o One from the front eye bolt to the back of the marquee frame.
 - Repeat on the opposite side.

Umbrella Setup

• Use cam buckle ties on **all four corners** of the umbrella frame, securing into the four anchor points.

Pack-Up Instructions & Safety Tips

- 1. **Remove Eye Bolts** at the end of the day to avoid trip hazards.
- 2. **Replace Grub Screws** (flush with concrete) to protect the anchor point.
 - Twist gently by hand first, then use the Allen key.
- 3. Avoid releasing cam buckle ties from eye bolts during pack-up:
 - Instead, drop your marquee to the ground first.
- 4. **Facing the wind?** Bolt one marquee foot in first, then fully extend and secure the rest.
- 5. Don't skip grub screw replacement:
 - Dirt/sand will block the anchor hole.
 - You won't be able to use it next week.
 - Damage may result in charges.
